






















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





















SUN WINDSOCK

 This is called a "kite fold". Then flip the paper over to the back.




 Now fold up the bottom point as shown to form the neck. To make the head, fold the point partially down as shown in A above. Then lold the entire shape in half, as shown in B.



Pull the neck and head out and pinch the bases so they stay. Spread out the swan's body and it will stand up!








# **TELL TIME**

# **GOLD! DISCOVERY**




Gold is a very popular metal. There are many uses for gold such as, jewelry, electronics, or painting. The Great Gold Rush in the 1800's caused many people to mave to California in search for gold and fortune.

Chalcopyrite, fool's gold, is sometimes mistaken for gold. Calcopyrite is a type of copper. The color is green yellow. This metal is hard but flakes off.







"Gold panning" means searching for gold in rivers. Panning uses a pan to sift through the river banks. The water washes away the dirt and if lucky, leaves gold pieces.
